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### **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

Our Capabilities Statement presents our corporate organizational structure, corporate-wide expertise, previous contract experience, facilities, and qualifications of our key personnel. S&L Enterprise will have a tightly integrated staff that possesses knowledge and skills that have been demonstrated on a range of related efforts.

### **1.1 OVERVIEW**

S&L Enterprise, Inc. was established in October 2001 with the goal of providing high quality planning, programming, budgeting, financial management, training, research and information technology services to Government and industry. S&L Enterprise is headquartered in Springfield, Virginia with offices in Alexandria, Virginia, Jackson, Mississippi, and Flint, Michigan. S&L Enterprise is a small minority women owned, disabled veteran owned business under Federal Regulation Title 13, Section 121.3-8. Our initial customer was the Citizen Accounting and Tax Services, Incorporated, later the U.S. Army Space and Missile Defense Command. S&L Enterprise has contracts with the Department of the Army, the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and the United States National Guard Bureau.

Our business strategy is to provide experienced personnel for engineering services to the Government and industry. Our staff is primarily comprised of senior personnel with more than 29 years of experience, all with advanced degrees. The resources of S&L Enterprises are dedicated to solving and contributing to the solution of problems of local organizations and national interest. This capability is available to undertake complex, multidisciplinary programs.

### **1.2 CAPABILITIES**

A Program Manager will be assigned responsibility for each program, including the support from other elements of S&L Enterprise, as necessary, to meet contractual commitments.

## 2.1 PAST CONTRACT EXPERIENCE

S&L Enterprise has contracts with the Department of the Army, the United States Army Corps of Engineers, the United States National Guard Bureau, and previously with the United States Army Space and Missile Defense Command. We are proud to have supported The Department of the Army (DAMO-PMG) The Pentagon, the TRADOC Systems Managers Office Ground-based Midcourse Defense, and the United States Army National Guard Bureau as our first partners and contracts at federal and state levels.

SLEI has served as the lead contractor to USACE operating under GSA Order W912BU05P0068. SLEI provided direct support to USACE Provost Marshal Division. The role included supporting the Provost Marshal Division with a subject matter expertise (SME) in the Schedule 75 development process as well as an expert in the Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE) process. The primary focus for support was in the areas of Antiterrorism, Physical Security, Law Enforcement and Facilities Preparedness. SLEI supported UASCE with policy development, training, requirements and funding by advising and recommending solutions associated with the management of the program. SLEI provided expertise and personnel intimately familiar with Force Protection Conditions (FPCON), Homeland Security Terrorist Warning System measures and reporting systems necessary to protect the command's soldiers, civilian employees, family members, facilities and equipment.

**FP Contract-Related Past Performance:** For the past year SLEI has provided the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) FP Subject Matter Expert (SME) to evaluate, recommend, develop and implement existing and proposed Anti-Terrorism criteria, plans, guidance, policies, and mandatory standards for protecting USACE facilities and personnel, information, critical resources, key assets, and critical infrastructure from acts of terrorism.
